Parent Information Sheet - Primary 3

Topic

Your child will be learning about Dundee(Old and New) this term. We will be visiting Verdant Works and R.R.S. Discovery as part of our topic. The children will be asked to complete a Personal Home Project related to Dundee.

Maths

In maths your child will be developing his/her skills in:-**Inderstanding Number** - Counting, sequencing and adding multiples of Os and 100s up to 1000.

dd and Subtract - Revise subtraction to 20, subtract single digit from $h\sim$ multiples of 10 and re-visit addition to 100.

Multiply and Divide – Division by 2 and 10 and re-visit multiplication – 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Fractions - Halves, quarters and thirds, Learning to use appropriate vocabulary and symbols for fractions and learning to count in simple fractions on a number line.

Literacy

In Literacy your child will be developing his/her skills in:-**Reading** - Reading texts, completing new 'Reading Box' materials and comprehension activities.

Writing - Writing personal and imaginative stories, learning to take notes, Keys to Literacy Writing activities and Handwriting Practice. Talking and Listening - Circle Time, Talk into Writing, watching clips from internet about Dundee and having discussions with shoulder partners.

Homework

Your child will have weekly homework and we would appreciate if you could continue to support your child in completing his/her homework tasks and this should be returned to school each Monday. We would encourage you to read with your child - newspapers, comics, novels and reading books. Your child should have his/her reading book in his/her school bag every day. Thank you.
