Language – We will be continuing with the successful '**Big** '**Writing**' scheme where we are seeing an improvement in the children's writing. Some preparation for this will be done at home as a homework task. This is a ten minute discussion task.

Reading - The focus this term is to continue to improve the children's reading. We will use 'Literacy World' (the school reading scheme) and the 'Green Box' which is a reading comprehension scheme. We will study 'The Boy in the Stripped Pyjamas' in school and reading books will be going home as usual. Reading will be heard in class by myself or other adult.

Maths – At the moment we are looking at fractions and will be returning to other areas throughout the term. Problem solving and tables are on-going.

Topic – This term is WWII. I have asked the children to bring in any artefacts or stories they might have at home. These will be looked at, discussed and respected. We will look at film footage of events of the war as well as writing diaries, newspaper articles, stories and other language and art activities.
