



## Primary 6b – Term2

### Language

- We will continue to use the “Big Writing” scheme and will be writing pieces linked to our topic. For some of the pieces of writing the children will be given “Big Talk” homework to help them plan and prepare for the writing session, this should take around 10 minutes.

- This term our novel is “Goodnight Mr Tom” and we will be using Keys to Literacy to examine themes, character and setting further. We will also continue to carry out smaller Guided Reading sessions in class using the Literacy World scheme.

### Maths

- We will continue to revisit a variety of concepts over this term and encourage the children to see the links between the concepts.
- We will also be learning to calculate the area and perimeter and area of regular and irregular shapes.

### Topic

- Our topic this term is World War 2 and our focus in school will be The Home Front. In particular we will be looking at life at home, evacuees, The Blitz, rationing and the role of women.
- We will shortly be sending home a personal research task, which will give the children the chance to research an area of the topic which is of interest to them.
