### Language -

- We will be continuing with the "Big Writing" scheme and linking writing to our class novel and topic. The children will be given "Big Talk" homework to support their writing in class and we would appreciate your continued support with this.
- Our class novel this term is "Stormbreaker" and we will also be carrying out guided reading sessions in smaller groups using the Literacy World scheme. Homework will be issued in support of both the class novel and reading books.

### Maths -

- Our whole school approach to number this year will see the children revisiting concepts on a termly basis to encourage the children to recognise the links between the different elements of number.
- We will be looking at different units of measure in maths.

### Topic -

- We are looking at 2 science topics this term; "Energy" and "Chemical Changes".
- We will be encouraging the children to become energy detectives at school and home!
